Judging Contract For USAIGC/IAIGC Meet Directors & OFFICIALS

held in the 50 United States, Bermuda, Canada, South Africa and any other IAIGC International Country.

1. Official's Compensation

One Judge Panel \$130.00 per session

Two Judge Panel \$105.00 per session

2. Travel expenses are limited to: tolls, cabs, bus fares, train fares, airfares, parking, room accommodations (when required). The USAIGC/IAIGC **does not pay mileage.**

Exception: if a Competition has another Gymnastic Organization competing **prior to or after** a USAIGC/IAIGC session and are using the SAME Officials the Meet Director will pay mileage one-way (**non-USAIGC Competition**), **less the required 15 miles per USAG contract**

The USAIGC/IAIGC compensates our Officials at a higher session rate and will not allow the practice of “double dipping” to take place. .

3. Per Diem

One session: no meals

Two sessions: one meal

Three sessions: two meals.

Any over-night accommodations include Dinner and Breakfast the following day.

If food is not provided:

Officials will purchase their meals individually and present their meal receipt to the host club / Meet Director. The per diem scale is as follows:

Breakfast and / or Lunch up to \$15.00 + 15% tip. Dinner up to \$20.00 + 15% tip

4. Overtime Compensation:

Overtime Rate:

\$25.00 per Official for a competition session that exceeds 3 hours 10 minutes. **Additional Compensation** fee of \$25.00 shall be paid to each official if the competition exceeds 3 hours 40 minutes. If overtime is due to an injury or an unusual circumstance the Meet Director will not be obligated to pay the late fee. If there is no agreement on the overtime the matter will be brought forward to the USAIGC/IAIGC Office within 48 hours for a resolution.

5. Hiring USAIGC / IAIGC Officials

The USAIGC will hire National and International Officials at the request of their Meet Directors for their Sanctioned USAIGC Competitions. USAIGC/IAIGC Meet Directors have the right to hire their own USAIGC/IAIGC Officials with one exception Downstate New York will be assigned by our USAIGC Technical Director for ALL Competitions involving USAIGC Gymnasts.

6. Judging Pool

The USAIGC/IAIGC has a judging pool listed on our website. ONLY Officials who attend the USAIGC/IAIGC FREE Coaches and Officials Clinics and are posted on our USAIGC/IAIGC Judging Pool and may be selected to judge a USAIGC/IAIGC Competition.

7. Insurance

USAIGC/IAIGC insurance covers all of our Gymnasts, Coaches and Officials Judging our Sanctioned Competitions. No other Judging Contract may be used.

9. Officials Responsibility: a. Fully understand the USAIGC/IAIGC Rules & Policies set forth in our Rules and Policy Book available on line or at the Official's request, a Hard Copy will be sent to free of charge.

The USAIGC/IAIGC is an **Optional Only Competitive Program** with our own Code of Points, Rules & Policies.

b. Dress as a Professional with any combination of red, white and blue.

c. Arrive 15 minutes prior to the Start Time Posted for the Competition.

d. Handle all inquiries in a timely and professional manner.

e. Greet the gymnasts and Coaches prior to the competition on your event and make sure everyone understands the warm-up and compete process.

f. Have your **start values and scores "up"** in a timely manner.
